



Introduction: Submitting your assignment and viewing the originality report

Dear students,

This is a very short tutorial to show you how to submit your assignment and how to view SafeAssign originality report.



What is SafeAssign?

- According to Blackboard, SafeAssign is primarily a "plagiarism prevention tool."
- It checks your paper for similarities with other materials submitted in the same college you are attending, other colleges where students submitted their papers, online publications, and anything published on the internet.
- In case you use excessive quotations or paraphrasing, it is an opportunity for you and your instructor to discuss the option to revise and resubmit to make sure you are using correct attributions and citations.

The example of the paper that was submitted includes only one direct quotation from Bartley and Golek and a reference to another author Carol Dweck, which were correctly attributed and referenced, and two references cited at the end. Do not be alarmed because of the language used in SafeAssign. Your instructor will let you know about any concerns with your submission. You also have the opportunity to revise your paper before it is graded and shorten the quotation if your instructor allows multiple attempts.

Multiple attempts to improve the SafeAssign Originality Report



Exclude submissions from the Institutional and Global References Databases

For example, In IDS 101, you are allowed two attempts to submit your draft in week 6. After you submit the second draft of the research paper and view the SafeAssign originality report, you can resubmit a second time after you revise your draft to improve the originality report.

I have been asked to share my experience with attending school on-line and talk about my motivation or any challenges I have faced. Like many traditional students, I attended college in-person for a few semesters and stuck to a schedule that required me to use transportation and sit in class a few times a week. When I had the chance to switch to online instruction, I got to experience attending school online, and, since then, I have decided to continue my college education online since it provides me a with flexible schedule, saves me money, and provides me with an online community. Attending school online provides me with a flexible schedule. Can it get better than having the opportunity to log in anytime that is convenient to me and do my work? All I need is a reliable internet connection, a very functional computer, and a quiet space to do my work at my pace and my leisure. I have realized that I do not have to be confined to a physical location/classroom or a set time to achieve my goal, which is completing my education and graduating. The other flexibility in my schedule is that even if I do not feel well, I get to enjoy access to the course materials and study at my pace as long as I am participating and meeting the due dates; I do not have to worry about missing work to make money to support myself. Time management is one of the important factors that concern not only the student, but also working adults; Bartley and Golek (2004) discussed the hardships that adult students face, particularly those who have to do with time and distance. Attending school online saves me money. Since I started taking classes online, I have been spending less money on gas and on car maintenance. I don't have to eat out at lunch or dinner. I have realized that attending school online has made me aware of how to better handle my finances. I have started saving and I have realized that I get to use that money that I save on eating out to do my weekly shonning and naving my hills. 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have started saving and I have realized that I get to use that money that I save on eating out to do my weekly shopping and paying my bills. Attending school online has enabled me to use what Carol Dweck (2016) called "growth mindset": "Individuals who believe their talents can be developed (through hard work, good strategies, and input from others) have a growth mindset." Indeed, my attending college online has enabled me to use my online skills to start working online too, which has helped me to use less mileage on my car and save money on maintenance. Attending college online has helped me to find belong to a community of like-minded students. This is the community of students who share similar interests and deal with similar challenges. For the first time I have started enjoying the online discussion forums where I see my peers share their responses about assigned topics; reading other discussion posts and having the opportunity to interact with my peers and my instructor via discussions, including the Q&A forum, have been instrumental in making me feel that I am heard and that I belong to this academic online community. I have talked about the benefits; this reflection would not be complete without mentioning a challenge. The question here is about whether there is one challenge or challenges. It all depends on each individual and how each handles such challenges. Since I am self-reflecting, one of the challenges that I dealt with in the past was how some instructors released the course materials one week at a time and they only thing that gave me solace and kept me going was going back to the syllabus and asking instructors questions about upcoming assignments. This is not a challenge any more since the course I am taking gives me access to all the weeks' materials and assignments. The access to resources that I have now such as academic advising, online tutoring, the online library, and my instructors' contact information and their readiness to respond via email, weekly discussions, and weekly feedback on assignments is refreshing and settling. Another bonus to help with the potential challenge of being "alone" online is that the college has an alumni association that provides support to other students. From my experience, a good online school or class is one that provides you access to the entire course right from the start of the term. This enables me to be better organize my time to enjoy flexibility, to save money on expenses, and to belong to an academic community.
